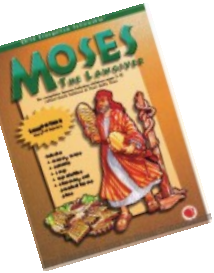

"When you complain about the meals you are given instead of being grateful, **you sin**. When you pout because you can't have your own way or slam your bedroom door so everyone knows you're angry, **you sin**. "The **punishment** for even one sin is separation from God forever in **Hell**. **You deserve** God's **punishment**...." *Life of Christ 1*, p35.

"**You deserve to go to Hell**...." *Elisha*, p10.

"[Y]ou **deserve** to be **punished** for your sin.... [T]he **punishment** you **deserve** for your sin is to be separated from Him forever in a **terrible place of suffering**. **Unless you follow his plan, you will be punished**." *Moses*, p29.

Teacher's Question: "**What is your punishment for sin if you don't get saved?**"

Answer preschoolers prompted to give: "**Being away from God forever; not going to Heaven.**" *Moses*, p35
